



KOEFIA, A HISTORY OF QUALITY

Koefia Academy was founded in 1951 and was the first fashion school established in Italy by Countess Toni Alba Brasini, artistically known as Koefia.

Born into an artistic family and originally from Ravenna, she developed a revolutionary method of garment creation, characterised by cutting patterns directly on the mannequin rather than on the table, following a three-dimensional working technique.

The 3D pattern-making method still distinguishes Koefia Academy today, specialising in the design and production of Haute Couture garments and collections, in keeping with the couture tailoring tradition that has made Italian fashion renowned worldwide.

For many years Koefia Academy has been included in international rankings, placing 22nd among the world's top 100 fashion schools and 18th among Europe's top 50 fashion schools.

Koefia Academy takes pride in having trained hundreds of students who have gone on to work in prestigious ateliers, with internationally renowned fashion designers and leading companies in the industry.

Since 2013, Koefia Academy has collaborated with important international educational institutions by offering post-secondary academic programmes (Bachelor's Degrees) and postgraduate programmes (Master's Degrees), accredited by E.A.B.H.E.S. (European Accreditation Board of Higher Education Schools).

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN DESIGN FASHION DESIGN Design & Research



Teaching focuses on the research and design of Haute Couture garments and collections.

Students develop skills in fashion illustration, anatomy, colouring techniques and digital illustration, complemented by Pattern Making and Garment Construction, which are integral to Koefia's educational method.

These skills culminate in the Graduation Project presented as the final thesis and completed with a fashion show featuring selected garments created in the Academy's *ateliers*.

Interpreting trends, designing garments and collections by hand or digitally, selecting fabrics, producing garments and presenting them to the public are the essential skills required for success as a Fashion Designer.

An optional internship in prestigious fashion houses and companies completes the programme.

BACHELOR OF PROFESSIONAL STUDIES FASHION DESIGN Couture



The programme provides specialised education focused on garment development and production.

Garments are produced according to Haute Couture standards, pursuing the highest level of quality.

After completing the design phase, students are guided by Koefia's Master Tailors through Haute Couture Pattern Making and Tailoring, developing their creativity, culture and manual skills. Approximately two-thirds of the programme is dedicated to atelier activities involving the design and production of garments and collections.

Every year Koefia Academy participates in international competitions and fashion shows. Every garment presented on the runway is entirely conceived and produced by students within the Academy, from the initial concept through illustration, textile decoration, knitwear and garment construction.

The third academic year is primarily devoted to the development of the Graduation Collection and the final Fashion Show.

The three-year programmes

are intended for all young people who have a passion for fashion and wish to follow a professional educational pathway in order to enter leading companies in the fashion and Haute Couture sectors.

Every year Koefia Academy places dozens of graduates in leading ateliers and fashion houses, including Armani, Pierre Cardin, Cavalli, Brunello Cucinelli, Dolce & Gabbana, Fendi, Ferragamo, Gucci, Jil Sander, Jimmy Choo, Max Mara, Yves Saint Laurent, Sarli, Trussardi and Valentino.
